PROMOTIONAL ITEMS

- ☐ **Caution Decals (Full Kit)**
Caution stickers help remind operators of safe operating practices and comply with OSHA regulations. They're a simple but vital part of the workplace.
- ☐ **Seatbelts**
Seatbelts are important because they help keep the operator inside the forklift frame during a tip-over, reducing the risk of serious injury or death. They are a key part of safe forklift operation.
- ☐ **Horn**
The horn is important for alerting others of the forklift's presence, especially at intersections, blind spots, and/or in noisy environments. This keeps both operators of other equipment and pedestrians safe.
- ☐ **Mirrors**
Mirrors are important because they may help the operator's visibility of blind spots, surrounding areas, and pedestrian traffic.
- ☐ **Back-up Alarm**
A backup alarm can help alert nearby pedestrians, other operators, and workers when a forklift is reversing.
- ☐ **Seat Switch**
A seat switch ensures the truck only travels/lifts when the operator is properly seated. This safety feature prevents unintended travel or movement of the hydraulic functions.
- ☐ **Headlights/Taillights**
Headlights and taillights improve visibility in low-light areas and alert others of the forklift's presence.
- ☐ **Blue Lights**
Blue lights project a visible beam on the ground, which can assist in alerting others nearby of an approaching forklift.
- ☐ **Strobe Lights**
Strobe lights enhance visibility by drawing attention to the moving forklift especially in busy or dimly lit areas. This can alert both pedestrians and other operators.
- ☐ **Floor Mats**
Floor mats provide better traction for the operator. They also add comfort and help maintain a cleaner operating area.
- ☐ **Fire Extinguisher**
A fire extinguisher can provide quick access in case of a fire at the customer's facility.
